Neighbor Consent Form

The applicant must receive consent from **all** adjacent neighbors to continue with the application process. The pilot program is available to a maximum of five (5) households. Approved properties will be allowed a minimum of two (2) and a maximum of four (4) hens.

The pilot program places significant requirements on Urban Hen Keeping applicants to ensure the wellbeing of the hens, as well as to mitigate concerns around odors and nuisances.
