Back Alley

Just a reminder to residents that the strip of grass between your back (or side) fence and an alley way is the residents responsibility.

RV Parking

Camping season is upon us and recreational vehicles will soon be seen around the community. Pursuant to the Traffic Bylaw 10/16 Section 3, RV's must be attached to a vehicle by which it may be drawn and can be parked on a roadway in Town for no more than twenty-four (24) consecutive hours. After the 24 hours the RV must be moved to an off-road location for forty-eight (48) hours before it may return. RV's must be parked on a paved or gravel pad and cannot be parked on lawns/grassy areas.

Fire Season

Residents are reminded to be aware of the rules as well as the hazards associated with outdoor fire pits, portable fire pits and fire safety. For more information please refer to Bylaw 01/24 Regional Fire Services.
