Yard and Fall Cleanup

Fall is fast approaching and it is time to make sure that your home and property are prepared for the fall season.

- Cut grass and clear weeds that could attract animals and pests;
- Trim trees and shrubs so that they don't overhang alleys and sidewalks;
- Rake/gather any fallen leaves, twigs and branches;
- Hot tubs and pools must be drained to the front street (NOT the back lane); and
- Pet waste cleanup should be conducted frequently and ideally before the snow falls.

Reminder: Tax Installment Payment Plan

The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) Bylaw 05-23 allows residents to sign up for a monthly, direct withdrawal of their property tax payments from their bank accounts.

This plan provides taxpayers the opportunity to pay their property taxes in monthly installments rather than the one large single payment that comes due once per year.

The plan runs from January 1 - December 31 yearly. You are eligible to join the TIPP if:

- Your tax account is paid in full and you have no arrears or penalties from previous years;
- You have an account with chequing privileges at a financial institution;
- You do not currently pay your taxes through a mortgage company;
- Your application is received by March 15 of the current year, provided that a pro-rated portion of your taxes are paid in advance.

Applications received after March 15, 2025 will not be eligible for the 2025 Tax Installment Payment Plan.

Municipal Tax Rebate Program

This program allows for prospective developers to apply for a property tax rebate up to three-years, offering an incentive to developers to invest in Lamont. Eligibility:

- New residential or commercial construction projects which are constructed on vacant lands.
- New residential or commercial construction projects which are replacing existing structures.
- Applicants must be the legal landowner as listed on the Certificate of Title.
- The rebate program only applies to the municipal portion of taxes and does not apply to taxes on the land assessment or the requisitions, such as the Alberta Education requisition and the Lamont County Seniors Foundation requisition.
- New construction with approved development and building permits dated after May 12, 2021.
- Property taxes must be current at the time of application.
- All new construction must conform to the current Town of Lamont Land Use Bylaw and Alberta Building Code regulations.

The rebate is restricted to one new construction per lot. Application Deadline: December 1st each year.
