Tax Penalty

Reminder that an 18% penalty will be applied to the full balance of any tax accounts outstanding after December 31, 2024.

Tax Installment Payment Plan - TIPP

The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) allows residents to sign up for a monthly, direct withdrawal of their property tax payments from their bank accounts.

This plan provides taxpayers the opportunity to pay their property taxes in monthly installments rather than the one large single payment that comes due once per year. The plan runs from January 1 - December 31, yearly. For the 2025 taxation year, 2024 taxes must be paid in full and your application must be received no later than March 15, 2025, provided that a pro-rated portion of your taxes are paid in advance.

Black Knot

Now is the time to remove black knot from any trees on your property. Remove infected branches to at least 6-8 inches below the knot. Cutting blades should be cleaned and disinfected after each cut. For knots on scaffold branches or trunks that can't be removed, cut away diseased tissue down to good wood and at least one centimeter beyond the edge of the knot. Diseased wood must be destroyed immediately (burned, buried or removed and disposed of at the landfill).

Snow Removal

As per Bylaw 05/24, Community Standards, the owner or occupant of any property adjacent to a sidewalk is responsible for the removal of all snow and ice from that portion of the sidewalk within **seventy two (72) hours** of a snowfall. Snow removed from driveways, parking lots, service lots or sidewalks shall NOT be placed or moved onto highways/streets, sidewalks or private property.

The Town will be monitoring sidewalks after snowfalls. Residents who do not clear the snow from adjacent sidewalk will be fined.
